Dates of Application	March 12 to April 27: To start exchange in the second half of the same year. The duration of the academic period ranges from the first week of August to the third week of December. September 3 to October 26: To start exchange in the first half of the following year. The duration of the academic period ranges from the last week of January to the third week of June.

Application Documents	 Fill out the form for incoming mobility application - Foreign Students Application letter from the home University Registration of Applicants in Academic Mobility. Download here Academic History with Cumulative General Average (GPA). Letter of Intent expressing reasons for interest in Mobility. Letter of recommendation from at least 1 teacher. Curriculum vitae Photocopy of current passport. Spanish Knowledge Certificate - Level B1 Applicants for Visual Arts and Design programs must submit a portfolio on CD/DVD. Applicants to the music program must submit a filmed sample of their work on CD/DVD or an internet medium. They should also include videos of their musical presentations. Applicants for medical rotations must first apply to docencia.servicio@ucaldas.edu.co. It is essential that the student register the subjects required by their home university, the application for subjects must have the approval of the Academic Coordinator at their home university.

immigration procedures

Students may enter the Colombian territory for an academic semester of exchange with a type V visa, if their stay is less than 180 days, they may enter with a Permit of Integration and Development (PID) Authorization granted by Migración Colombia to foreign citizens who intend to enter the national territory to carry out activities where there is no desire for profit including academic efforts.

International Health Insurance	With the application, all international students accept that they must purchase an international medical insurance that covers medical, dental and funeral repatriation expenses, valid in Colombia for the duration of their stay in our country.
Accommodation	Caldas University does not have university residences for foreign students; however, assistance is provided to help students find accommodation near the campuses. The approximate cost of living is between \$1,100,000 and \$1,500,000 COP (equivalent to 250 to 350 USD).
Grading Scale	Between zero point zero (0.0) and five point zero (5.0) and will have only one decimal, the minimum passing grade for Undergraduate Programs is three point zero (3.0) and for Postgraduate Programs three point five (3.5). Thus notes cannot be made equivalent on a scale of 0 to 10.
